

If you test positive for COVID-19

If you get a Positive result from your Rapid Molecular COVID Test or PCR nasal swab test, please note the following:

1. You and those traveling with you will not be allowed to go through security or board a plane to fly.
2. XpresCheck is required to inform the state Department of Health (DOH) and Centers for Disease Control (CDC).
3. You should stay in isolation for 10 days. You must stay away from friends and family, and you cannot go to work.
 - If you need to find temporary alternate living arrangements, XpresCheck can refer you to local resources.
4. If you are short of breath or having difficulty breathing, please seek medical help right away at an Urgent Care Center or Emergency Room.
5. Notify your primary care provider that you have tested positive for COVID-19.
6. Notify your employer, and have your employer notify your co-workers that someone in their workplace (without mentioning you by name) has tested positive for COVID-19.
7. Please notify any person you may have come in contact with in the last 5–7 days that you have tested positive.
 - Encourage them to get tested.
 - It is recommended that they do not board a plane until they have spent 14 days in quarantine, or have gotten a negative COVID-19 test.
8. If you need a negative COVID-19 letter to return to work or for any other reason, please get re-tested in 10–14 days.
